1. Before Jesus ascended, He first descended. vs 9

- 2. Peter confirms this account from the Old Testament
- 3. What hell was like before the resurrection of Jesus
  - a) Hell: (Hebrew-Sheol; Greek- Hades)-The place of departed souls; a place of confinement, a holding place
- 4. In hell Jesus took on the punishment that was meant for us.

When He went to hell, He experienced separation from God;

Spirit, Soul, and Body. God actually turned his face from Jesus and totally forsook him in his State of exchange with us....that is why Jesus cried, My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

- a) He took on all agony and punishment that we would ever experience (all men for all time).
- 5. Jesus spoiled principalities and powers.

Colossians 2:15

- a) Spoiled: Greek: To strip or to unclothe.
- b) Webster's Dictionary: To strip the hide from an animal; to completely disarm a defeated foe; damage or injure in such a way as to make useless; destroy.
- c) Spoiling of principalities and powers the Greek word used is Apeckdunomai" on the devil and all his cohorts. That describes

- a ceremony practiced in the Roman Army where the metals of the defeated general belonged to the conqueror. Totally stripping the other General of all titles, authority, etc... His right to conquest, He had to do it legally!!!!
