Treasure of the New Heart

Scriptural References:

1 John 2:20,27 You have an unction (an appointment and assignment) from the Holy One...

2 Co 4:6-7 We have this treasure in earthen vessels...This is the miracle, that such Holiness could abide IN US! But He does it by way of making us new through Christ! We become vessels of Honor...

2 Tim 2:19-21 Vessels of gold/honor, We must treat this great honor with great honor.

2 Co 2:14-16 The fragrance of Life, the fragrance of death.

Jeremiah 31:34 He put in us a new soft heart replacing the old, thus He has solved the problem of sin and separation from Him by re-creating us.

Hebrews 8: 10-11 Engrave them on their hearts - He has put in us a voice or a conscience and so we are aware when we are straying from His will and His ways. We are now fully accountable for our actions,

Hebrews 9: 11-12, 14 Christ appeared as a High Priest of better and more perfect things... The old covenant with it's way of forgiveness of sin, was very temporary and required daily penance and blood sacrifice. The new covenant not only forgives our sin, but forgets about it, and has provided a way for us to have everlasting fellowship with God who is a Spirit and Who is perfect.

Hebrews 10:16-17, ...I will imprint My laws upon their hearts and I will inscribe them on their minds (on their inmost thoughts and understanding)...by this fresh new living way which He initiated...

Colossians 1:15-20 He is the exact likeness, the first born of all creation, through Him all things should be completely reconciled back to Himself...

Colossians 2:2-3,9-10, For in Him the whole fullness of Deity continues to dwell in bodily form, and You are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life in Christ you too are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life in Christ you too are full with the Godhead - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Colossians 3:1-4 If then you have been raised with Christ to a new life, aim at and seek the rich eternal treasures that are from above...

Phil 2:13 Not in our own strength for it is God who is all the while effectually at work in you...

Ephesians 1:10-11, 16-23 He planned for the maturity of the times to unify all things and head them up...and so that you can know and understand what is the

immeasurable greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength...

Ephesians 2:10 *For we are God's own handiwork recreated in Christ Jesus, that we may do those good works which God predestined for us...*

Proverbs 4:23, 15:13 *Keep and guard your heart with all vigilance and above all that you guard, for out of it flow the springs of life.*

***Ezek. 11:19** *And I will give them one heart [a new heart] and I will put a new spirit within them; and I will take the stony [unnaturally hardened] heart out of their flesh, and will give them a heart of flesh [sensitive and responsive to the touch of their God].*

Ezek 36:26-28 *...and I will put my Spirit within you and cause you to walk in my statutes, and heed my ordinances and do them.*

Mt 5:8 (Amp) *Blessed (happy, enviably fortunate, and spiritually prosperous-possessing the happiness produced by the experience of God's favor and especially conditioned by the revelation of His grace, regardless of their outward conditions) are the pure at heart, for they shall see God!*

When God does a work in us to recreate our very being's and make us after His type, everything changes. We become new creatures! Christ was the covenant that God was talking about in Ezekiel, and Christ said, "It is finished" when He was on the cross. The redemptive work has been done, and when we truly allow God to do His work on the inside of us creating in us a new heart, there is no denying it. Sometimes we can receive the gift of a reborn spirit, and still hang on to our old ways. But we can't stay old for very long, because God gives us new wine and new wine skins. We are the temple (the new wine skin) of the Holy Spirit (the new wine), He now abides on the inside of us. As 2 Corinthians 4: 6-7 states, we have this treasure in earthen vessels.
